Entry is open to yachts eligible to race in the J24 One-Design Class. Entry fee is \$80.00 if entered at the website below or postmarked by Saturday, July 31st, 2011. Entries received postmarked after July 31st are subject to a \$20 late fee.

The intended racing area will be the Berkeley Circle area with windward/leeward, triangular, or a combination of both type of courses set up using inflatable marks.

The first Warning Gun each day will be at 1130 hrs. Warning Gun for each succeeding race will be made as soon as practically possible. No warning shall be made after 1530 hrs.

The low point scoring system RRS A4 shall be used. Seven races are scheduled. A minimum of one race shall be completed to constitute a series.
